PROGRAM: Marvin Miller – Turning Threaded Boxes

Marvin went through procedures to making boxes with threaded lids. He brought and showed some tools he made. Explained preparing wood blank. Outlined steps: drill hole to fit chuck, part off lid and bore lid before threading. Put a relief for thread stop and square thread area. He uses cutter to thread and uses CA glue to stabilize before last cut. Bore the bottom, prepare for threading, use calipers to determine thread diameter, cut threads and check fit. Used video to show threading procedure. Marvin answered questions.

AUCTION: Richard Gulley and Doyle McConnell handled the auction duties. They were great at getting great prices for all donated items.

The auction raised \$1,116.00 for the club. Great participation.
